

Linton Primary School

Intent

At Linton Primary School, children learn to appreciate and respect different beliefs and ways of life. Our children will be taught how to make connections between religious and non-religious beliefs and will be given regular opportunities to share, listen and reflect. Children will be supported to articulate their own beliefs and to listen thoughtfully to the beliefs of others. We want children to gain knowledge and skills through experiences in the classroom but also to use religious artefacts and visits to places of religious significance.

Implementation

To ensure that high quality RE is taking place throughout the whole school we implement a curriculum which is progressive from EYFS through to Year 6. RE lessons are planned in accordance with the Derbyshire Agreed Syllabus for RE 2020-2025. Every pupil has an entitlement to religious education and RE is a necessary part of a broad and balanced curriculum.

Impact

The RE curriculum will promote inquisitive minds, respect, tolerance and understanding for all those around them. Through their R.E. learning, the children are able to make links between their own lives and those of others in their community and in the wider world. This evidence will be seen through using the correct vocabulary, explanations and respectful opinions, as well as cross-curricular evidence.
