Equipment:

Punctuality

All children should be in class by 8:30am, although 8:20am is preferred and encouraged.

Homework

Children should read every day - this doesn't have to be to an adult, but please sign their reading diary. They have access to online learning and should practise their times tables daily, which could be done using TT Rockstars. They are also encouraged to complete independent research and projects related to learning in school. Homework books will contain log ins, times tables sheets, a glossary of grammatical terms and a list of spellings. Homework will be given on a Friday and should be returned on a Tuesday.



Forest Schools is every Thursday. Please ensure children have suitable outdoor clothing (trousers, jumper, waterproof, boots, wellies or old trainers, gloves, hat).

Testing in Year 6

All children will sit National Curriculum Tests (SATs) in the summer term - **week commencing 11th May**.

In English, they will sit tests on Grammar, Spelling and Reading.

In Maths, they will sit an Arithmetic test and two Reasoning tests. There will a SATs booster club starting in January.
