Minutes of the last meeting shared, matters arising:

The homework grid was explained, children are rewarded for however many tasks that they complete.

PSHE Relationships topic - parents were asked what they thought Relationships Education meant for primary aged children

Ideas included - different types of parents, wider families including step -parents etc, quality of relationships, good and not so good relationships, what 'no' means

LW shared pages from PSHE matters, the framework used to guide learning. This has not been updated for 18 months, so other resources are also used.

Parents looked at learning for Early Years, KS1, Lower and Upper KS2 and hi-lighted activities that they thought were interesting and should be included in the plans for HT6. They also suggested other ideas that could be incorporated. Lots of the ideas linked back to stories, clips and scenarios that could bring ideas into real life.

Samples of PSHE books were shared, showing that children are able to record their understanding by drawing and writing, taking notes or asking questions.

Social media was discussed - how children are taught to use this safely. An idea that playing games online could be one of the scenarios, also comparing actions in the digital world v the real world.

Mrs Wilson will now use parents' ideas when planning the PSHE for next half term.

RSE Day -will be on 26th June. Ideas for activities in class, whole school and at home were shared. Parents chose some that they liked. The theme is **Communication** so all activities will link to this. We will be asking parents to get involved during the week.
