Parents' Forum Minutes 30.3.22 at 9.00

- Welcome

Present: CH, FS, LW, MD

Rationale:

LW explained that there has been some talk in the media about alleged inappropriate content being taught in schools.

At Linton we do not use any inappropriate content.

Dfe are going to be conducting a review into the content being used in schools.

Reviewed and agreed.

- RSE policy review

LW talked through the Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) policy 2020.

This is due for renewal in May 23.

Part of the process is to review our policy with parents, which is why we are looking at it today.

All agreed the policy.

- Bert Award update

'Building effective relationships together.'

LW gave background information about this award. We secured bronze last year and are now aiming for silver and gold.

This has included the recruitment of RSE ambassadors in school.

The gold award includes parental engagement.

LW would like to create a 'parent group' to work alongside our ambassadors.

Plan to involve Y6, who will be asked to speak to their parents about RSE.

Parent group would have regular meetings, discuss what will be taught in school etc.

LW shared some of the children's 'Growing up books.'



'Period bags' (name TBC) will soon be available in toilets.

Plans to conduct a parent survey - it is hoped that the parent group would assist with that.

Some concern from FS that not enough parents know what RSE is.

How many parents would be appropriate for the group? Ideally around 10?

LW to first hold an RSE after school event/showcase/come and see, which would include our RSE ambassadors. Aim to recruit parents following this.

It might be that the parents of our RSE ambassadors could be approached.

CH suggested inviting Governors.

CH discussed how the SEND coffee morning was well attended because parents were individually targeted and this strategy might work for the RSE parent's group.

LW shared future plans for Anti-stigma ambassadors.

LW to arrange the parent event in summer term one. **Action LW.**

Provisionally set for 8th June.

Need to discuss what to call it and how to maximise attendance.
