Parents' Forum Minutes 10.2.26 at 8.45

- Minutes of the last meeting were shared and briefly discussed.

Parents felt that sometimes it feels early to be sharing some information with children. It was recognised that children are entering puberty earlier and school needs to prepare children for this.

A parent questioned the menu choices for gluten free children - CH said she would discuss with the kitchen.

A parent said that the 'Neurohubs' meetings were very good, they helped support parents of neurodiverse children. Following this, a parent noted that their child was reluctant to use computers and panics on Mathematics. This might be difficult during the multiplication screening. The parent planned to talk to their child's class teacher.

Another parent said that their child had had a positive first term, that the EY staff were fantastic and their child had been welcomed.

The group visited all classes from Honeybees to Stags.

A parent commented that in some classes, children have their water bottles on their tables. CH said this was likely to be older children, whereas younger children's bottles are accessible. The parent asked for children to be reminded to take a drink.

A parent asked if children are made aware that some pupils have support for their additional needs - ie wobble cushions and 'chewies', that these items are not a reward but because a child needs them for support. Their child had wanted a chewy because someone else had one.

Another parent commented on the lovely feeling around school, the welcoming atmosphere and the children's purposeful learning. All classes were calm and focused on their learning.
