OUR SERVICES



Autism Services: Providing diagnostic assessments, practical and emotional support for autistic children and their families.



Equipment: Supporting families with mobility and sensory equipment to help children and young adults with their development, mobility and independence.



Workshops: Providing families with a range of resource sessions that focus on raising a child with a disability or an autistic child.



Kids' Activities Club: Hosting activities for children and young people with SEND. These sessions are fun, help with social skills and build their confidence.

Every child is different, with their own strengths and individual potential. That's why we work closely with families to create personalised support that helps each child build their future in their own way.



AUTISM ASSESSMENTS

We deliver Autism Assessments for children aged 4-11, so they can learn to understand their strengths and differences, empowering them to be themselves.

Our in-house clinical team completes the two-day assessment, and every family receives post-diagnosis wraparound support and workshops to help you feel informed, supported, and confident moving forward.

FAMILY SUPPORT

Every family is allocated a Family Support coordinator who offers personalised support after the assessment. They help you put new strategies and recommendations into practice, and you'll also have access to virtual and in-person workshops that focus on many of the common differences associated with raising an autistic child.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Caudwell Children's Occupational Therapy service helps children and young people aged 0-18 to achieve their goals. We assess and support with everyday tasks:

- ✧ At home
- ✧ At school
- ✧ During play
