-View RSE Day learning

Mrs Wilson had displayed learning from RSE day in the Dining Room. There were also samples of KS2 Growing Up books, showing progression in learning. Parents looked at the learning displayed and the book samples.

Mrs Wilson talked the group through the activities that were done on RSE day, some of which the Parents' Forum had helped to plan.

The theme for RSE day 2026 was 'It Begins with me'

Activities included every child writing a positive statement about themselves on a leaf and decorating it to make a class tree, asking children how they see themselves, a self-love camera where children drew snapshots of their lives. KS1 looked at similarities and differences.

The children learned a lot.

View growing up books

All learning is recorded in these books. The children choose how and what to record. It is there learning and their understanding - therefore limited marking.

New guidelines for PSHE are out as mentioned before at Parents' Forum, the 12 modules haven't changed, but the guidelines are more specific about what to teach, especially being safe which includes road, rail and water safety. A handout was shared.

A discussion on vocabulary and appropriate terms followed. A parent was glad that school teaches children the vocabulary.

Mrs Wilson said that school was close to achieved BERT Gold, the assessment is on 2.10.26.
