We believe in kindness, respect, positive attitudes and equal opportunities.

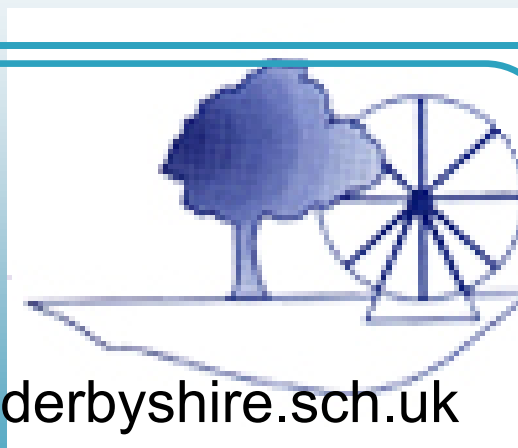
We will promote enthusiasm and enjoyment of learning. We work as a team and encourage everyone to 'aim high'.

- Article 16 -

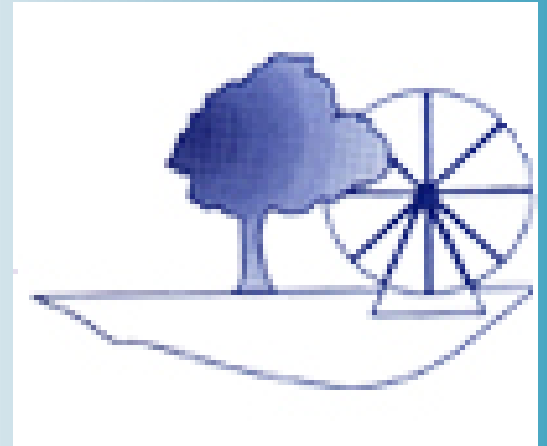
You have the right to privacy.
