

History

Our topic is: The Ancient Greeks. This will include: Chronology, locations on a map, key events, Alexander the Great's empire. daily life and society, comparisons and contrasts between Athens and Sparta and Ancient Olympics comparison to modern.

Maths

We will be learning about:

Multiplication and Division - Multiplying a 4-digit number by 1 digit and 2 digits, problem solving, short division with remainders and efficient division.

Fractions - Multiplying a non-unit, unit and mixed number by an integer, fraction of a quantity and finding the whole.

Decimals and percentages - Equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages; thousandths as fractions, decimals and on a place value chart; and ordering, rounding and comparing decimals.

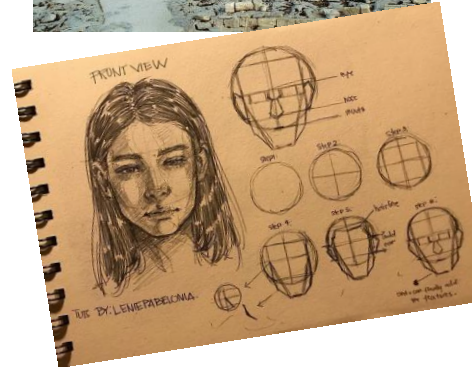
PE

We will be focussing on dance and using the REAL PE scheme of work to focus on stance and footwork.

Science

Our science topic is: Movement, forces and magnets. This will include:

- Understand that force and motion can be transferred through mechanical devices such as gears, pulleys, levers and springs.
- Understand that some mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.
