## Science

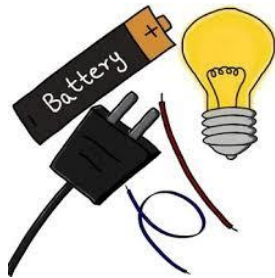
We are learning about electricity in science this term.
