## English

### Snowy Sentence Writing

- Ask your child to write 3-5 sentences about the snow.
- This could be:
  - What they can see outside
  - What they would like to do in the snow
  - A short snow day story
- Encourage:
  - Capital letters
  - Finger spaces
  - Full stops
- Children may also add a picture to go with their writing.

## Spellings

Conduct your very own spelling test. **play, eat, boat, make, three, most, drain, toe**

## Maths

### Number Practice

- Practise counting forwards and backwards to 20 (or beyond if your child is confident).
- Ask your child to:
  - Write the numbers 1-20 in numeral and words
  - Find objects around the house and count how many there are
- If possible, children can also log in to Mathletics using the details in their reading records and complete one or two activities.
